Preliminary studies suggest that paw paw can be used with antioxidants.

Fred Valeriote Ph.D. at the Ford Cancer Center in Michigan has conducted a study with the Paw Paw Cell-Reg and several types of antioxidants. The official study report has not been sent, but via phone conversations, the information was relayed to Bill Keller Ph.D. in the Health Science Department at NSF.

Several antioxidants were tested with the Paw Paw. This includes Super Antioxidant, SOD, Thai-Go, Noni, Carotencid Blend, Green Tea, Grapine, and Vitamin C. In the cancer cell. culture study there was no marked inhibition of the action of the: paw paw due to the presence of the antioxidants_

E hope this information is useful to you. In the future when we receive the final reports, NSF` wild bereleasing more detailed information.
